TRAINING:	<p>Complete the following National Incident Management System training courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• IS-100: Introduction to ICS</li><li>• IS-200: Basic ICS</li><li>• IS-700.A: NIMS, An Introduction</li><li>• IS-802: ESF 2 – Communications</li></ul> <p>IS-100 and IS-200 are required before applying to team. SKYWARN and CPR/First Aid/AED training is recommended.</p>
EXPERIENCE:	<p><i>One to two years of active participation with a local ARES® or RACES group. Demonstrate voice and digital radio capabilities by participating in a major Simulated Emergency Test and be certified for this capability by a section leader responsible for team. To retain membership, participation is required in on-going training and demonstrating operational proficiency on an annual basis.</i></p>
LICENSING:	Current FCC Amateur Radio License.
OTHER:	Pre-arranged deployment agreements with employer.
